



## IDEA

We want to show that scouting is an extremely interesting social movement involving young, ambitious and unconventional people. People who can work together independently of the political situation in the world. They do not know prejudice against other nations or religions. They disagree with the world's widespread inequalities and actively work towards positive changes in their environment. Scouting is the elite of today's youth.

The tour is extremely varied and it is designed so that the participants touch and experience the power of nature so that they have the opportunity to meet wild animals and test their wilderness skills. At each stage (with a few exceptions), four people from Poland and two scouts from the "transit country" will participate. The task of the leaders will be to select proper people to run their stages. We want at least half of the Polish team to be scouts. You do not have to be worry about bikes and camping equipment, we organize them for you and then we will transfer it from stage t stage.

Keeping up with the questions you may be getting: Bike Jamboree is not a type of a trip you apply, you receive a program and, if the hotel's star rating does not match, you write a complaint to the organizers. No. You are the organizers. By deciding to participate in a particular stage, you are challenged to reach the agreed start point of the stage, then bike it on a set time and pass the relay sticks to the next crew - also at the pre-arranged place on the road. Contrary to appearances it is not difficult at all. We provide equipment (bicycles, pouches, t-shirts, tents and, additionally on winter stages, special winter down sleeping bags and clothes). We support you in solving problems that arise, take care about security, logistic coordination, promotion, communication, etc., but what will happen during the stage depends primarily on you. We will tell you that this is the coolest thing in this whole game.

Costs. We are trying to gather sponsors (material and financial), but each participant must be ready to pay for the purchase of visas and airline/train/bus tickets, covering the cost of getting to the starting point of the stage and returning from its place of completion and providing the means to live for the duration of the stage (accommodation, food, etc.). So: the answer to the question "how much does it cost?" largely depends on the answer to the question "which stage?". The good news is that the cost of living while riding a bicycle and having a tent on the trunk and a sleeping bag are usually minimal, or at least lower than the cost of accommodation in the same period (say: month) in your home country. Unless you are going to buy very expensive souvenirs...

What else? Except for the candidates for stages I, III, XXIX and XXXIV, the participants must be over 18 (these four listed / exceptional stages will also collect more participants). We would also like to make sure that everyone who chooses to go does not only actively engage in the organization of his/her stage, but also, to the extent of the abilities and talents, engage in activities related to general organization and promotion of Bike Jamboree, whether by being "ambassadors" of the project in their home cities and societies.
